



The Department Chair Success Program

The Department Chair Success Program (CSP) is a 12-week virtual experience designed to support current and aspiring academic chairs as they navigate the complex transition from faculty member to academic leader. Through structured learning, real-world scenarios, and small group support, participants gain the clarity, tools, and confidence needed to lead well and sustain themselves while doing it. Participants engage in weekly training modules, coaching-led small group meetings, and reflection-based assignments that support personal and professional growth.

PROGRAM FORMAT

- **Weekly Modules:** Curated lessons on key chair competencies with accompanying videos, text, and reflection prompts.
- **Small Group Coaching:** Weekly Zoom sessions led by an experienced coach, offering discussion, feedback, and accountability.
- **Peer Community:** Connect with fellow chairs navigating similar roles, building trust, shared learning, and support.
- **Interactive Exercises:** Real-world scenarios, simulations, and decision-making challenges help deepen skills.
- **Optional Office Hours:** Private 1:1 sessions with your coach to discuss role-specific challenges and goals.

Weekly Training Modules

You'll explore core leadership skills through structured modules focused on real chair responsibilities—from strategic planning and budgeting to managing conflict and faculty development. Modules include video guidance, text-based reflection, and interactive activities to deepen your learning.

Small Group Accountability

Meet weekly with a small, hand-picked group of department chairs led by an experienced coach. These sessions provide space to reflect on the week's content, share challenges, and receive practical feedback. Many participants say this is the most valuable part of the program.

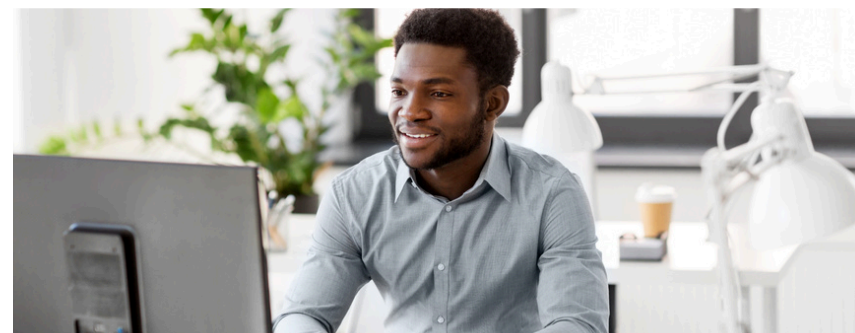
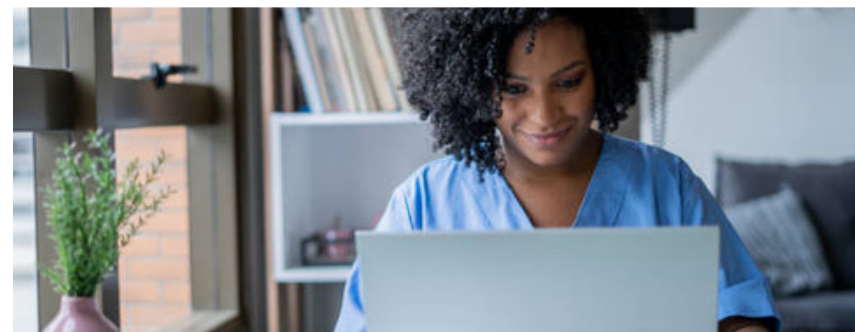
Peer Connection

Optional 1:1 Coaching

Office Hours are offered during key weeks to give you space for individual support. These short sessions are a chance to dig into a specific challenge or get tailored advice to support your goals.
