The Faculty Success Program

For faculty at all levels, including tenure-track, non-tenure-track, and tenured faculty.

The demanding nature of academia, with its trifecta of teaching, research, and service responsibilities, often leaves faculty members feeling overwhelmed and burned out. 47% of faculty don't feel like they have a strong well-being and balanced workload, according to our survey.
